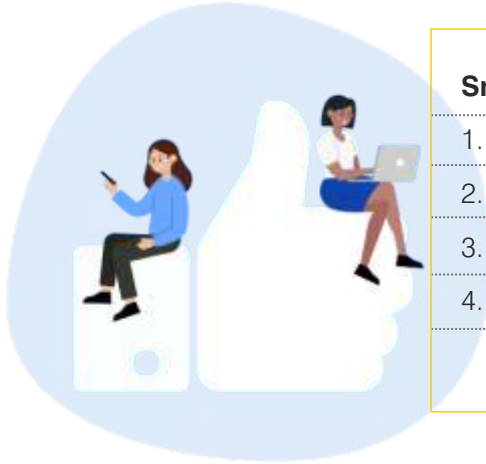
GUIDELINES FOR THE PARTICIPATING ORGANISATIONS

- Selected candidates should be notified before the conclusion of the campus placement.
- Once after letter is issued and accepted by the candidate, it should not be withdrawn or modified without the consent of the ICAI.
- ICAI shall not be involved in any litigation or dispute or loss/ damage in connection with the campus interview.



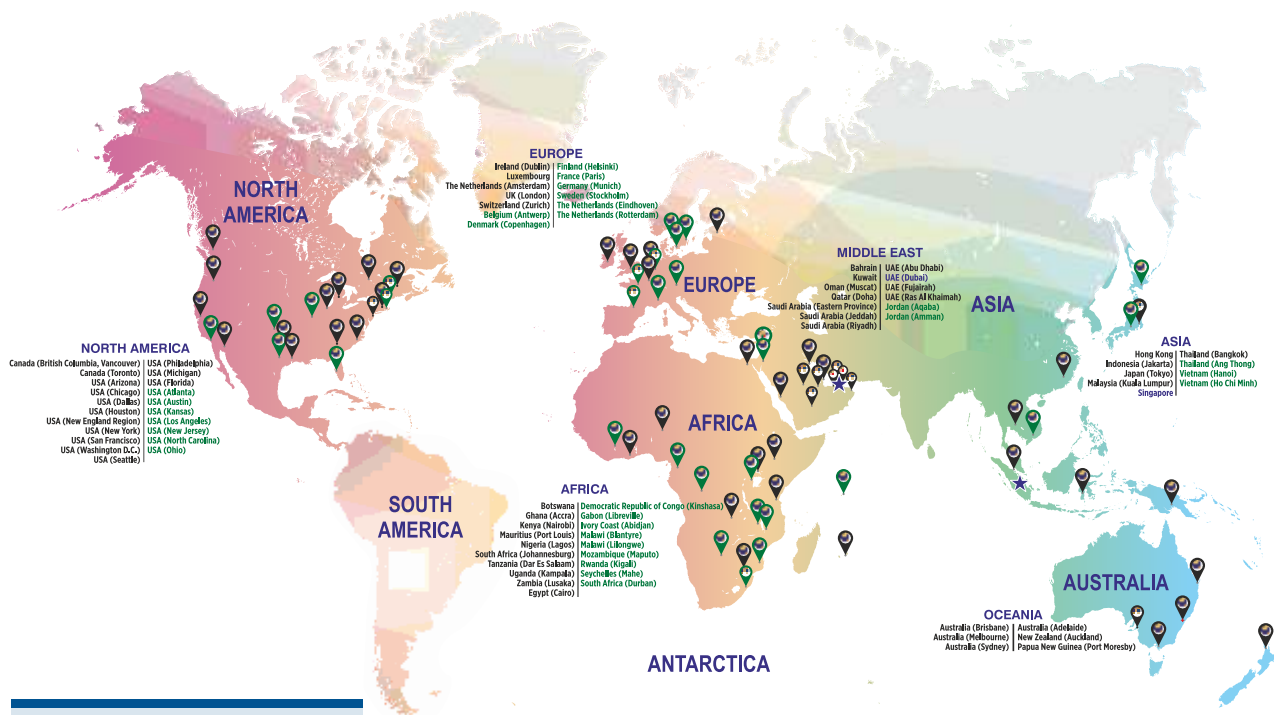
